Matt. 14:13 ¶ aNow when  
Jesus heard about John,  
He withdrew from there in a  
boat to a secluded place by  
Himself; and when the  
people heard of this, they  
followed Him on foot from  
the cities.





Mark 6:30 ¶ The apostles gathered around Jesus, and told him all that they had done and taught.

Mark 6:31 He said to them, “Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while.” For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat.

Mark 6:32 And they went away in the boat to a deserted place by themselves.





Mark 6:33 Now many saw  
them going and recognized  
them, and they hurried there  
on foot from all the towns  
and arrived ahead of them.





Mark 6:34 As he went ashore, he saw a great crowd; and he had compassion for them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.





Mark 6:35 When it grew late, his disciples came to him and said, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is now very late;

Mark 6:36 send them away so that they may go into the surrounding country and villages and buy something for themselves to eat."





Mark 6:37 But he answered them, "You give them something to eat..."





Mark 6:37 ...They said to him, "Are we to go and buy two hundred denarii worth of bread, and give it to them to eat?"





Matt. 10:1 ¶ Then Jesus summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to cure every disease and every sickness.





Mark 6:13 They cast out  
many demons, and  
anoointed with oil many  
who were sick and cured  
them.





Mark 6:45 ¶ Immediately  
Jesus made His disciples get  
into the boat and go ahead of  
Him to the other side to  
Bethsaída, while He Himself  
was sending the crowd away.  
Mark 6:46 After bidding them  
farewell, He left for the  
mountain to pray.
