Matt. 15:32 ¶ And Jesus called His disciples to Him, and said, “I feel compassion for the people, because they have remained with Me now three days and have nothing to eat; and I do not want to send them away hungry, for they might faint on the way.”





Mark 6:56 And wherever he went, into villages or cities or farms, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged him that they might touch even the fringe of his cloak; and all who touched it were healed.





Mark 7:5 So the Pharisees and the scribes asked him, “Why do your disciples not live according to the tradition of the elders, but eat with defiled hands?”





Mark 7:6 He said to them, "Isaiah prophesied rightly about you hypocrites, as it is written, 'This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; Mark 7:7 in vain do they worship me, teaching human precepts as doctrines.'





Mark 7:21 For it is from within, from the human heart, that evil intentions come: fornication, theft, murder, Mark 7:22 adultery, avarice, wickedness, deceit, licentiousness, envy, slander, pride, folly. Mark 7:23 All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person.”





Mark 7:24 ¶ From there he set out and went away to the region of Tyre. He entered a house and did not want anyone to know he was there. Yet he could not escape notice,

Mark 7:25 but a woman whose little daughter had an unclean spirit immediately heard about him, and she came and bowed down at his feet.

Mark 7:26 Now the woman was a Gentile, of Syrophoenician origin. She begged him to cast the demon out of her daughter.



Matt. 15:23 But he did  
not answer her at all.  
And his disciples came  
and urged him, saying,  
“Send her away, for she  
keeps shouting after us.”





Mark 7:27 He said to her,  
“Let the children be fed  
first, for it is not fair to  
take the children’s food  
and throw it to the dogs.”





Mark 7:28 But she  
answered him, "Sir, even  
the dogs under the  
table eat the children's  
crumbs."





Mark 7:29 Then he said to her, "For saying that, you may go—the demon has left your daughter."

Mark 7:30 So she went home, found the child lying on the bed, and the demon gone.
