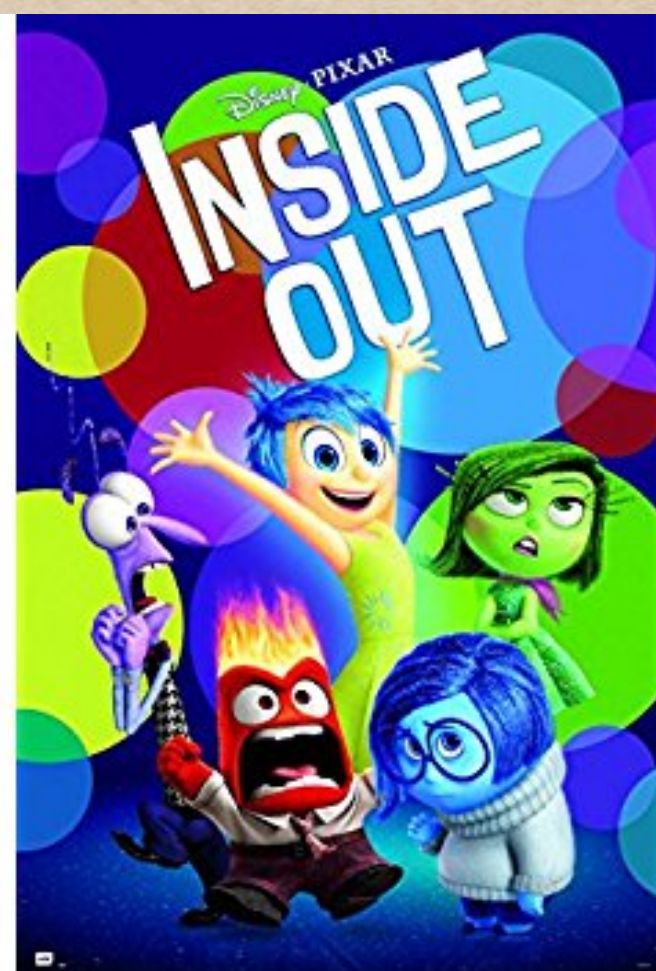

Eph. 4:27 and do not make room for the devil.

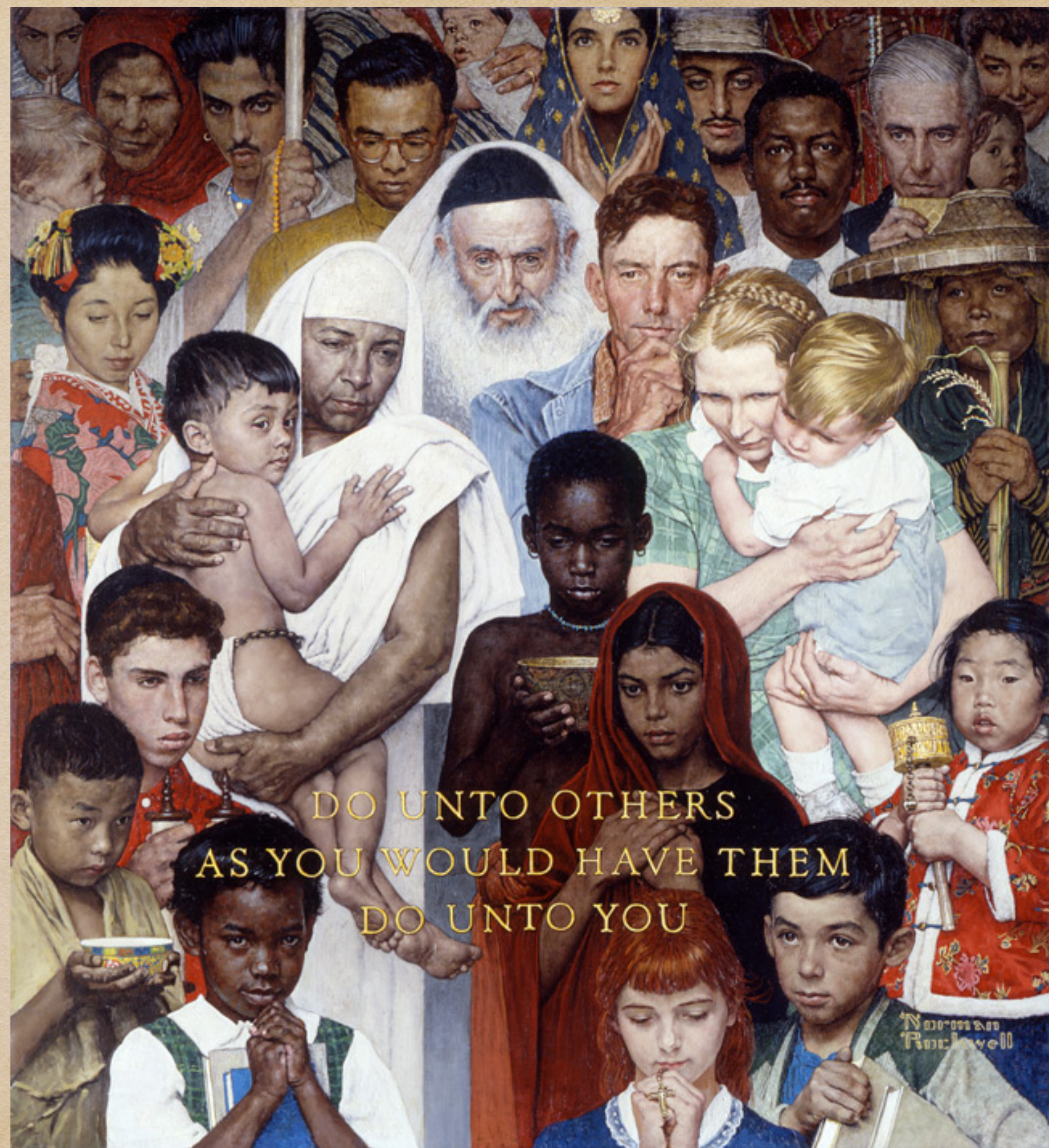
Eph. 4:28 Thieves must give up stealing; rather let them labor and work honestly with their own hands, so as to have something to share with the needy.

Eph. 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with which you were marked with a seal for the day of redemption.





Eph. 4:31 Put away from you all

James 1:19 ¶ You must understand

Gal. 5:21 envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these. I am warning you, as I warned you before: those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.





2Cor. 12:20 For I fear that when I come, I may find you not as I wish, and that you may find me not as you wish; I fear that there may perhaps be quarreling, jealousy, anger, selfishness, slander, gossip, conceit, and disorder.





Col. 3:5 ¶ Put to death, therefore,  
whatever in you is earthly:  
fornication, impurity, passion, evil  
desire, and greed (which is idolatry).

Col. 3:6 On account of these the  
wrath of God is coming on those who  
are disobedient.





Col. 3:7 These are the ways you  
also once followed, when you were  
living that life.

Col. 3:8 But now you must get rid of all such things—anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive language from your mouth.
