Rev. 2:12 ¶ “And to the angel of the church in Pergamum write:
These are the words of him who has the sharp two-edged
sword:

Rev. 2:13 ¶ “I know where you are living, where Satan’s throne
is. Yet you are holding fast to my name, and you did not deny
your faith in me^a even in the days of Antipas my witness, my
faithful one, who was killed among you, where Satan lives. 

Rev. 2:14 But I have a few things against you: you have some there who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the people of Israel, so that they would eat food sacrificed to idols and practice fornication.



Num. 25:1 ¶ While Israel remained at Shittim, the people began to play the harlot with the daughters of Moab.

Rev. 2:18 ¶ “And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write:

These are the words of the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and whose feet are like burnished bronze:

Rev. 2:19 ¶ “I know your works—your love, faith, service, and patient endurance. I know that your last works are greater than the first.



Rev. 2:20 But I have this against you: you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophet and is teaching and beguiling my servants to practice fornication and to eat food sacrificed to idols.



- ◆ Ephesus - post apostolic. Dealing with heresies.
- ◆ Smyrna - martyrdom. Diocletian. Ends with Constantine.
- ◆ Pergamum - Begins the mixture of civil & religious power.
- ◆ Thyatira - full blown fruition of authoritative heresy.



Thyatira -



◆ Instituted in 538 after last Arian threat and dismantled in 1563.

◆ Middle ages - Medieval church.

The Sword & the Cross - 500 to 1300 CE



- ◆ 1096-1099: First Crusade
- ◆ 1147-49: Second Crusade
- ◆ 1188-92: Third Crusade
- ◆ 1202-04: Fourth Crusade
- ◆ 1212 - Children's Crusade
- ◆ 1208 -29: Albigensian Crusade

Rev. 12:7 ¶ And war broke out in heaven; Michael and his angels fought against the dragon. The dragon and his angels fought back,

Rev. 12:8 and they were not strong enough, and there was no longer a place found for them in heaven.



Rev. 12:9 The great dragon was thrown down,
that ancient serpent, who is called the Devil
and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world
—he was thrown down to the earth, and his
angels were thrown down with him.



Rev. 12:12 Rejoice then, you heavens
and those who dwell in them!

But woe to the earth and the sea,
for the devil has come down to you
with great wrath,

because he knows that his time is short!”



Rev. 12:17 Then the dragon was angry with the woman, and went off to make war on the rest of her children, those who keep the commandments of God and hold the testimony of Jesus.

Rev. 13:1 And I saw a beast rising out of the sea having ten horns and seven heads; and on its horns were ten diadems, and on its heads were blasphemous names.

Rev. 13:2 And the beast that I saw was like a leopard, its feet were like a bear's, and its mouth was like a lion's mouth. And the dragon gave it his power and his throne and great authority.



Rev. 13:11 ¶ Then I saw another beast
that rose out of the earth; it had two
horns like a lamb and it spoke like a

Rev. 2:21 I gave her time to repent, but she refuses to repent of her fornication.

Rev. 2:22 Beware, I am throwing her on a bed, and those who commit adultery with her I am throwing into great distress, unless they repent of her doings;



Rev. 2:24 But to the rest of you in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not learned what some call 'the deep things of Satan,' to you I say, I do not lay on you any other burden;

Rev. 2:25 only hold fast to what you have until I come.
