Rev. 13:11 ¶ Then I saw another beast that rose out of the earth; it had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon.

Rev. 13:13 It performs great signs, even making fire
come down from heaven to earth in the sight of all;

had been wounded by the sword^a and yet lived;



Rev. 13:15 and it was allowed to give breath to the image of the beast so that the image of the beast could even speak and cause those who would not worship the image of the beast to be killed.



Rev. 13:16 Also it causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, to be marked on the right hand or the forehead,

Rev. 13:17 so that no one can buy or sell who does not have the mark, that is, the name of the beast or the number of its name.
