Heb. 12:22 But you have come to



Mount Zion and to the city of the living
God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to
innumerable angels in festal gathering,

Heb. 12:23 and to the assembly of the
firstborn who are enrolled in heaven,
and to God the judge of all, and to the
spirits of the righteous made perfect,



Heb. 12:24 and to Jesus, the



mediator of a new covenant, and to
the sprinkled blood that speaks a
better word than the blood of Abel.

Rom. 3:27 ¶ Then what becomes of boasting? It is excluded. By what law? By that of works? No, but by the law of faith.

Rom. 3:28 For we hold that a person is justified by faith apart from works prescribed by the law.



Rom. 3:29 Or is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles also? Yes, of Gentiles also, Rom. 3:30 since God is one; and he will justify the circumcised on the ground of faith and the uncircumcised through that same faith.



Rom. 3:31 Do we then overthrow
the law by this faith? By no means!
On the contrary, we uphold the
law.



Rom. 6:1 ¶ What then are we to say? Should we continue in sin in order that grace may abound?



Heb. 1:3 He is the reflection of God's glory and the exact imprint of God's very being, and he sustains^a all things by his powerful word. When he had made purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,
Heb. 1:4 having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.



Heb. 13:1 ¶ Let mutual love

continue.



Heb. 13:2 Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it.



Heb. 13:3 Remember those who are in prison, as though you were in prison with them; those who are being tortured, as though you yourselves were being tortured.



Heb. 13:4 Let marriage be held in honor by all, and let the marriage bed be kept undefiled; for God will judge fornicators and adulterers.



Heb. 13:5 Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER DESERT YOU, NOR WILL I EVER FORSAKE YOU,"

Heb. 13:6 so that we confidently say,

"THE LORD IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID.
WHAT WILL MAN DO TO ME?"



Heb. 13:9 Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings; for it is well for the heart to be strengthened by grace, not by regulations about food,^a which have not benefited those who observe them.



Heb. 13:10 We have an altar
from which those who officiate
in the tent have no right to eat.



Heb. 13:11 For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest as a sacrifice for sin are burned outside the camp.



Heb. 13:12 Therefore Jesus also
suffered outside the city gate in
order to sanctify the people by his
own blood.



Heb. 13:13 Let us then go to
him outside the camp and
bear the abuse he endured.



Heb. 13:14 For here we have no lasting city, but we are looking for the city that is to come.

Heb. 13:15 Through him, then, let us continually offer a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that confess his name.

Heb. 13:16 Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.



Heb. 13:20 ¶ Now may the God of peace, who brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant,

Heb. 13:21 make you complete in everything good so that you may do his will, working among us^a that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.
