Gen. 6:11 ¶ Now the earth was corrupt in
God's sight, and the earth was filled with
violence.



Gen. 10:8 Cush became the father of Nimrod; he was the first on earth to become a mighty warrior.

Gen. 10:9 He was a mighty hunter before the LORD; therefore it is said, "Like Nimrod a mighty hunter before the LORD."



Gen. 10:10 The beginning of his kingdom was Babel, Erech, and Accad, all of them in the land of Shinar.

sent letters and a present to Hezekiah, for
he heard that Hezekiah had been sick.



Dan. 1:1 ¶ In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it.

Dan. 1:2 The Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, along with some of the vessels of the house of God; and he brought them to the land of Shinar, to the house of his god, and he brought the vessels into the treasury of his god.



Dan. 1:4 young men without physical defect and handsome, versed in every branch of wisdom, endowed with knowledge and insight, and competent to serve in the king's palace; they were to be taught the literature and language of the Chaldeans.



Dan. 1:7 The palace master gave them other names: Daniel he called Belteshazzar, Hananiah he called Shadrach, Mishael he called Meshach, and Azariah he called Abednego.
