#### 1Kings 2:24 Now therefore as the LORD lives, who has established me and placed me on the throne of my father David, and who has made me a house as he promised, today Adonijah shall be put to death."

# Eccl. 1:12 ¶1, the Teacher, when king over Israel in Jerusalem,

Eccl. 1:13 applied my mind to seek and to search out by wisdom all that is done under heaven; it is an unhappy business that God has given to human beings to be busy with.



# Eccl. 1:14 I saw all the deeds that are done under the sun; and see, all is vanity and a chasing after wind.

Eccl. 1:16 ¶ I said to myself, "I have acquired great wisdom, surpassing all who were over Jerusalem before me; and my mind has had great experience of wisdom and knowledge." # Eccl. 1:18 For in much wisdom is much vexation, and those who increase knowledge increase sorrow.
