Luke 18:1 ¶ Then Jesus told them a
parable about their need to pray
always and not to lose heart.



Luke 18:2 He said, "In a certain city
there was a judge who neither
feared God nor had respect for
people.



Luke 18:6 And the Lord said,
“Listen to what the unjust
judge says.



Luke 18:3 In that city there was a widow who kept coming to him and saying, 'Grant me justice against my opponent.'



Luke 18:4 For a while he refused;

but later he said to himself,

'Though I have no fear of God and

no respect for anyone,



Luke 18:5 yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will grant her justice, so that she may not wear me out by continually coming.”



Luke 18:6 And the Lord said, "Listen to what the unjust judge says.

Luke 18:7 And will not God grant justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them?

Matt. 7:7 ¶ “Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you.

Matt. 7:8 For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened.



Matt. 7:9 Is there anyone among you who, if your child asks for bread, will give a stone?

Matt. 7:10 Or if the child asks for a fish, will give a snake?



Matt. 7:11 If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask him!



Matt. 10:17 Beware of them, for they will hand you over to councils and flog you in their synagogues; Matt. 10:18 and you will be dragged before governors and kings because of me, as a testimony to them and the Gentiles.



Matt. 10:19 When they hand you over, do not worry about how you are to speak or what you are to say; for what you are to say will be given to you at that time;

Matt. 10:20 for it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you.



Matt. 10:21 Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child, and children will rise against parents and have them put to death;

Matt. 10:22 and you will be hated by all because of my name. But the one who endures to the end will be saved.



Matt. 10:28 Do not fear those who

kill the body but cannot kill the

soul; rather fear him who can



destroy both soul and body in hell.

Matt. 10:29 Are not two sparrows
sold for a penny? Yet not one of
them will fall to the ground apart
from your Father.



Matt. 10:30 And even the hairs of your head are all counted.



Matt. 10:31 So do not be afraid; you are of more value than many sparrows.

Luke 18:8 I tell you, he will quickly grant justice to them. And yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"



Matt. 5:16 In the same way, let your
light shine before others, so that they
may see your good works and give

Matt. 6:5 ¶ "And whenever you pray, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, so that they may be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward.



Matt. 6:6 But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.



Matt. 6:7 ¶ “When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard because of their many words.
