Justin Martyr (100-165 C.E.)

- &God's law was for the Jews alone
- &Abraham did not live under it
- \$\presum Jesus did away with it
- &Christians live in a "new" dispensation Christ
- \$\precedure \precedure \text{Jews never understood or understand the Scriptures
- ©Only understood by Christians
- *Makes the church the true Israel



Edictof Milan - 313 CE

Removes any penalty or persecution for being a Christian.

Returns all property previously seized from the Church

Starts the era of "Christendom"

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Anti Semitism & Modern Racism


1843 - Charles Parwin publishes a paper that by 1849 becomes "The Origin of the Species"

Rom. 13:19 Let every person be subject to the governing authorities; for there is no authority except from God, and those authorities that exist have been instituted by God. Rom. 13:2 Therefore whoever resists authority resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur luagment.
