called children of God.



Matt. 5:38 ¶ “You have heard that it was said,
‘An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.’

Matt. 5:39 But I say to you, Do not resist an
evildoer. But if anyone strikes you on the
right cheek, turn the other also;



Matt. 5:40 and if anyone wants to sue you and take your coat, give your cloak as well;

Matt. 5:41 and if anyone forces you to go one mile, go also the second mile. 

Matt. 5:42 Give to everyone who begs from you, and do not refuse anyone who wants to borrow from you.

Matt. 5:43 ¶ “You have heard that it was said,
'You shall love your neighbor and hate your
enemy.'

Matt. 5:44 But I say to you, Love your enemies
and pray for those who persecute you,



Matt. 5:45 so that you may be children of
your Father in heaven; for he makes his sun
rise on the evil and on the good, and sends
rain on the righteous and on the
unrighteous.



Matt. 5:46 For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same?

Matt. 5:47 And if you greet only your brothers and sisters,^a what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same?



Matt. 5:21 ¶ “You have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, ‘You shall not murder’; and ‘whoever murders shall be liable to judgment.’

Matt. 5:22 But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment; and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council; and if you say, ‘You fool,’ you will be liable to the hell of fire.



1Sam. 18:20 ¶ Now Saul's daughter
Michal loved David. Saul was told,
and the thing pleased him.



2Sam. 6:5 David and all the house of Israel
were dancing before the Lord with all their
might, with songs and lyres and harps and
tambourines and castanets and cymbals.



2Sam. 6:14 David danced before the Lord with all his might; David was girded with a linen ephod.

2Sam. 6:15 So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the Lord with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet.



2Sam. 6:16 ¶ As the ark of the Lord came into the city of David, Michal daughter of Saul looked out of the window, and saw King David leaping and dancing before the Lord; and she despised him in her heart.



2Sam. 6:20 ¶ David returned to bless his household.

But Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David, and said, "How the king of Israel honored himself today, uncovering himself today before the eyes of his servants' maids, as any vulgar fellow might shamelessly uncover himself!"



2Sam. 6:21 ¶ David retorted to Michal, “I was dancing before the Lord, who chose me above your father and all his family! He appointed me as the leader of Israel, the people of the Lord, so I celebrate before the Lord.



2Sam. 6:22 I will make myself yet more contemptible than this, and I will be abased in my own eyes; but by the maids of whom you have spoken, by them I shall be held in honor.”

2Sam. 6:22 Yes, and I am willing to look even more foolish than this, even to be humiliated in my own eyes! But those servant girls you mentioned will indeed think I am distinguished!”



2Sam. 6:23 And Michal the

daughter of Saul had no child

to the day of her death.



Rom. 7:18 For I know that nothing good dwells within me, that is, in my flesh. I can will what is right, but I cannot do it.

Rom. 7:19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I do.



Rom. 7:20 Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I that do it, but sin that dwells within me.



Rom. 7:21 ¶ So I find it to be a law that when I want to do what is good, evil lies close at hand.

Rom. 7:22 For I delight in the law of God in my
inmost self,

Rom. 7:23 but I see in my members another law at
war with the law of my mind, making me captive
to the law of sin that dwells in my members.



Rom. 7:24 Wretched man that I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death?

Rom. 7:25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! ¶ So then, with my mind I am a slave to the law of God, but with my flesh I am a slave to the law of sin.
