Matt. 5:17 ¶ “Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.

Matt. 5:18 For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not one letter, not one stroke of a letter, will pass from the law until all is accomplished.



Matt. 5:1 ¶ When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him.


Matt. 5:2 Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:



Matt. 5:17 ¶ “Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.

Matt. 5:18 For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not one letter,<sup>a</sup> not one stroke of a letter, will pass from the law until all is accomplished.



Rev. 21:1 ¶ Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth;  
for the first heaven and the first earth had passed  
away, and the sea was no more. 

Rev. 21:5 ¶ And the one who was seated on the throne  
said, "See, I am making all things new." Also he said,  
"Write this, for these words are trustworthy and true."



Matt. 5:19 Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven.



Matt. 5:20 For I tell you, unless 

your righteousness exceeds that of  
the scribes and Pharisees, you will  
never enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matt. 5:21 ¶ “You have heard that it

was said to those of ancient times,

‘You shall not murder’; and ‘whoever

murders shall be liable to judgment.’





Matt. 5:22 But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment; and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council; and if you say, 'You fool,' you will be liable to the hell of fire.



Matt. 5:23 So when you are offering your gift at the altar, if you remember that your brother or sister<sup>a</sup> has something against you,

Matt. 5:24 leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother or sister, and then come and offer your gift.



2Cor. 5:17 So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation:  
everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!

2Cor. 5:18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself  
through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation;

2Cor. 5:19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to  
himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and  
entrusting the message of reconciliation to us.



Matt. 5:25 Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are on the way to court<sup>a</sup> with him, or your accuser may hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you will be thrown into prison.





Matt. 5:27 ¶ "You have  
heard that it was said, 'You  
shall not commit adultery.'





Matt. 5:28 But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart.



Matt. 5:29 If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to be thrown into hell.

Matt. 5:30 And if your right hand causes you to sin, cut it off and throw it away; it is better for you to lose one of your members than for your whole body to go into hell.



Matt. 5:31 ¶ “It was also said, ‘Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.’

Matt. 5:32 But I say to you that anyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of unchastity, causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.



Matt. 19:10 ¶ The disciples said to Him, "If the relationship of the man with his wife is like this, it is better not to marry."




Gal. 5:13 ¶ For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

Gal. 5:14 For the whole Law is fulfilled in one word, in the statement, "YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF."





Deut. 7:8 It was because the LORD loved you and kept the oath that he swore to your ancestors, that the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of  slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.
