




Matt. 1:23 "Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, "God is with us."



Job 40:19 And the Lord said to Job: Job 40:2 "Shall a faultfinder contend with the Almightu? Anyone who argues with God must respond."






