Dan. 7:21 As I looked, this horn made war with the holy ones and was prevailing over them,



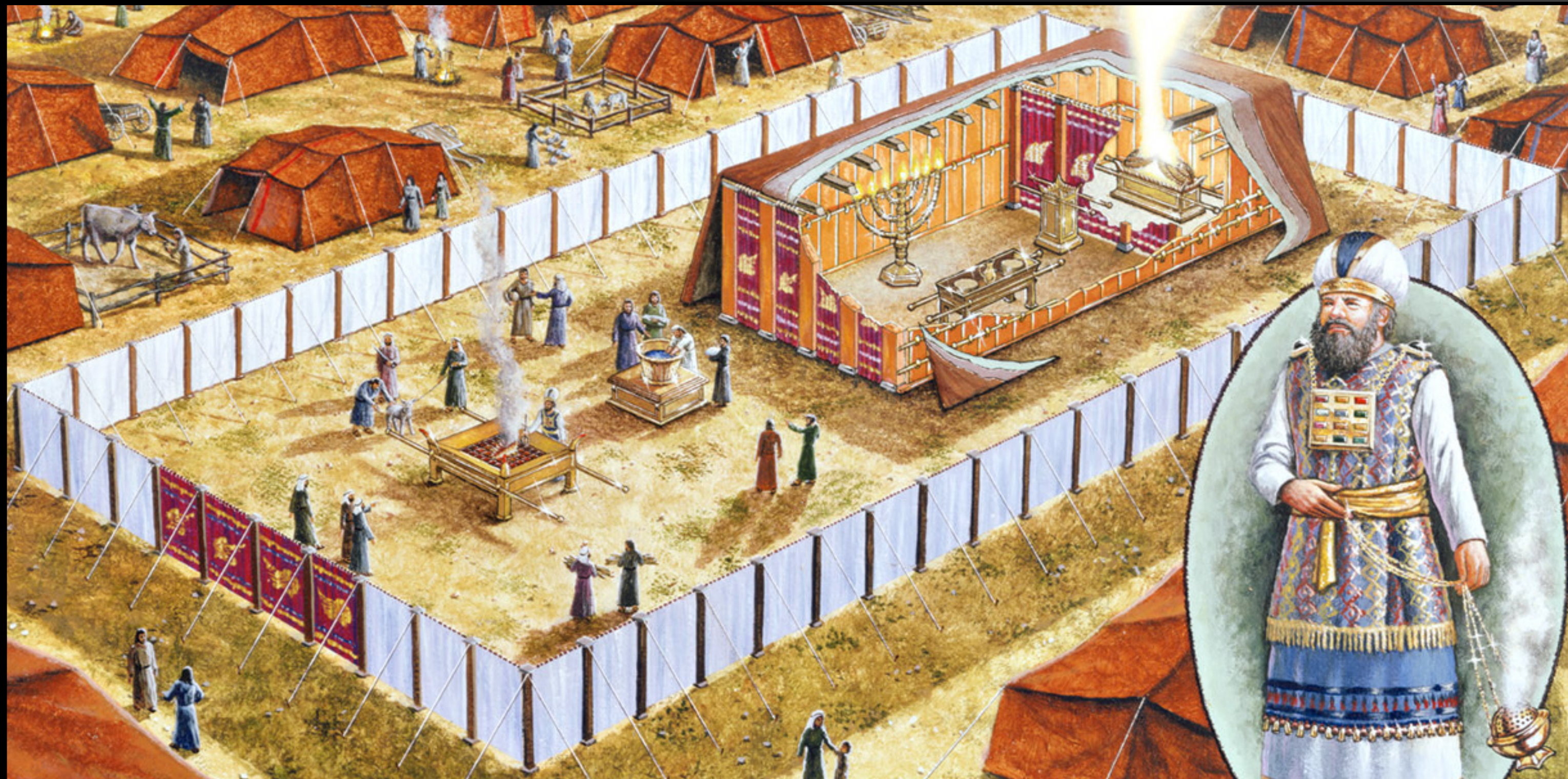
Dan. 8:9 ¶ Out of one of them came another horn,

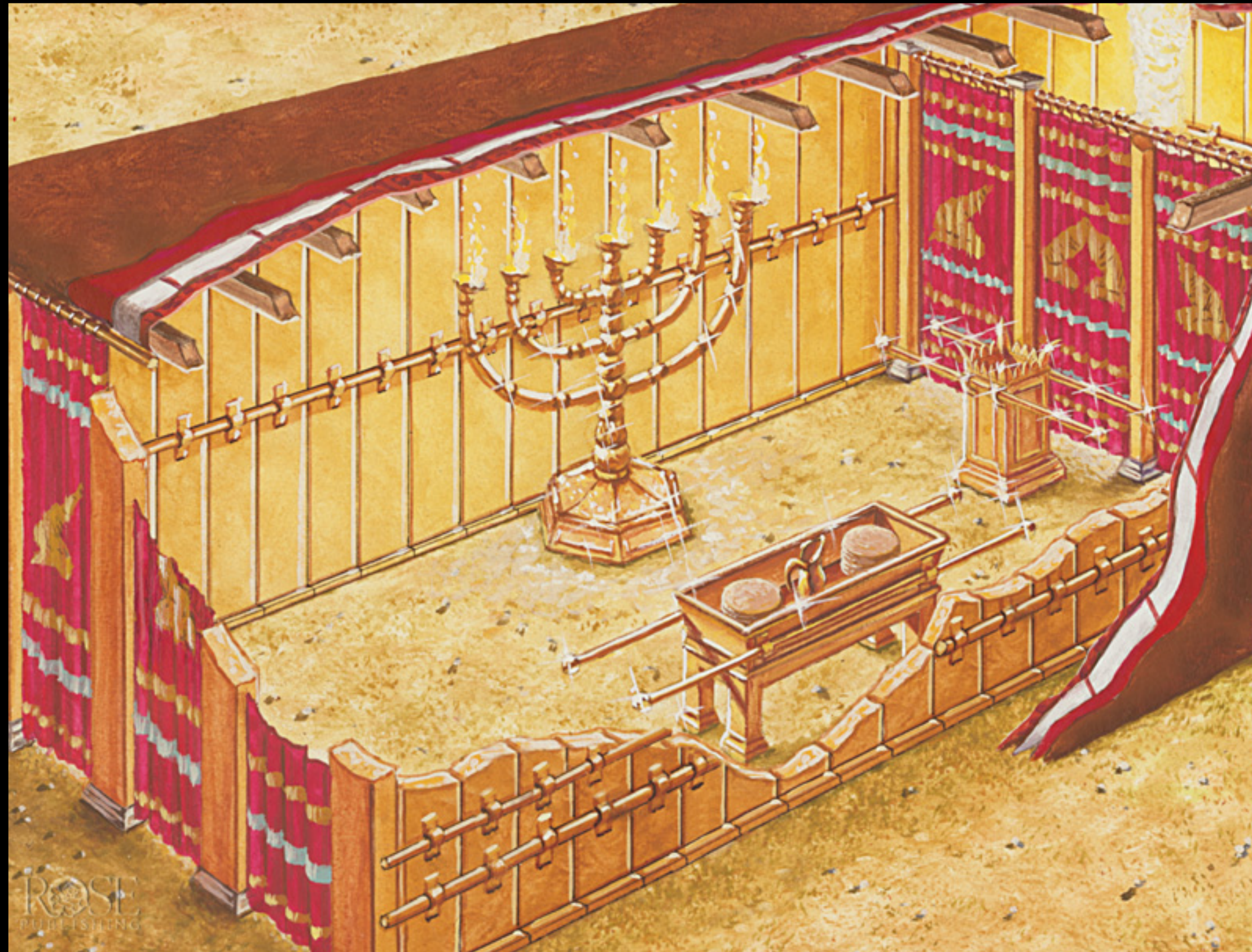

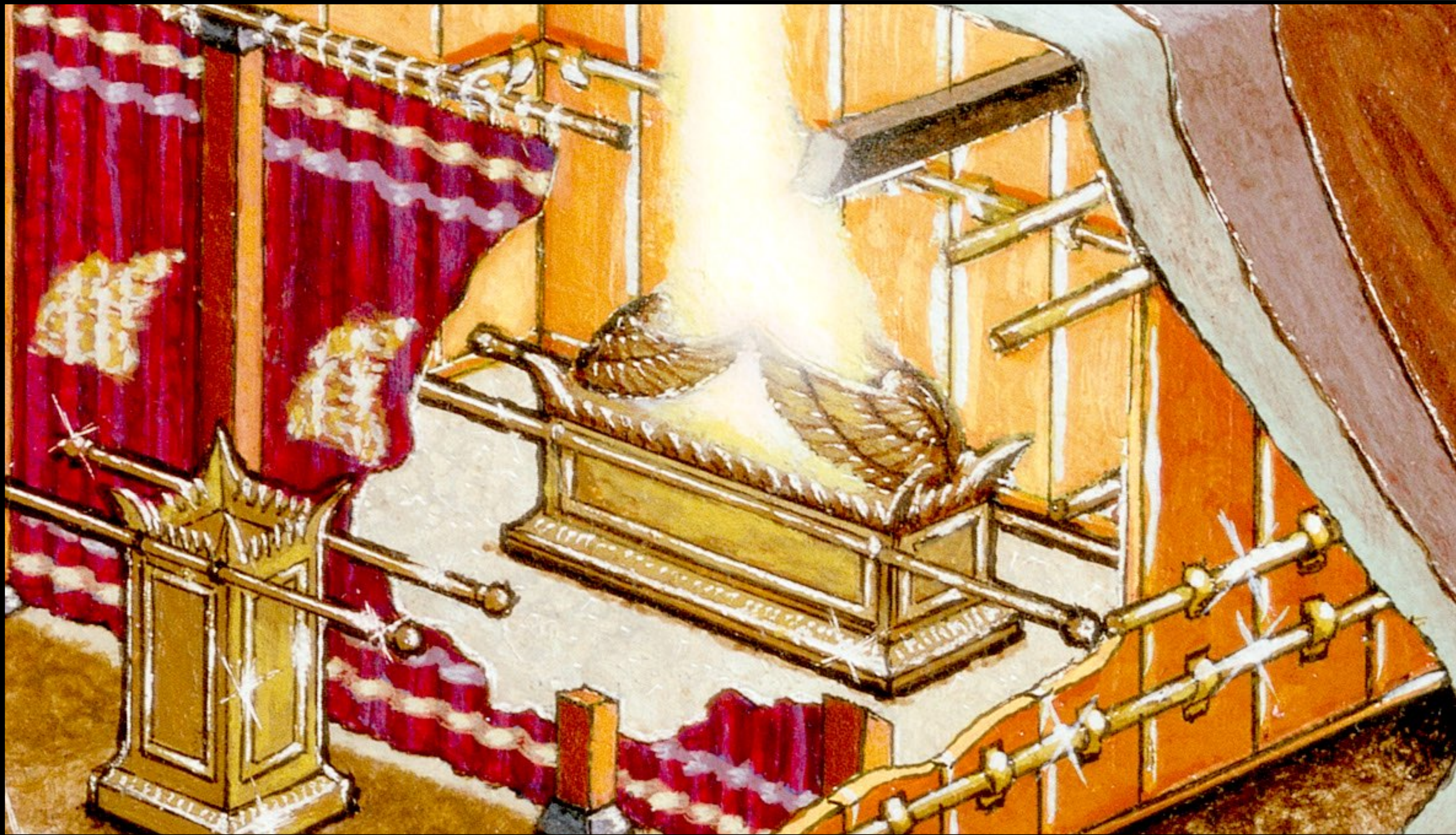

Dan. 8:1 ¶ In the third year of the reign of King Belshazzar a vision appeared to me, Daniel, after the one that had appeared to me at first.

Dan. 8:2 In the vision I was looking and saw myself in Susa the capital, in the province of Elam, and I was by the river Ulai.



Dan. 8:3 I looked up and saw a ram standing beside the river.^a It had two horns. Both horns were long, but one was longer than the other, and the longer one came up second.

Dan. 8:4 I saw the ram charging westward and northward and southward. All beasts were powerless to withstand it, and no one could rescue from its power; it did as it pleased and became strong.



Dan. 8:5 ¶ As I was watching, a male goat appeared from the west, coming across the face of the whole earth without touching the ground. The goat had a horn between its eyes.

Dan. 8:6 It came toward the ram with the two horns that I had seen standing beside the river, and it ran at it with savage force.



Dan. 8:7 I saw it approaching the ram. It was enraged against it and struck the ram, breaking its two horns. The ram did not have power to withstand it; it threw the ram down to the ground and trampled upon it, and there was no one who could rescue the ram from its power.



Dan. 8:8 Then the male goat
grew exceedingly great; but at
the height of its power, the
great horn was broken, and in
its place there came up four
prominent horns toward the
four winds of heaven.



Dan. 8:20 As for the ram that you saw with the two horns, these are the kings of Media and Persia.

Dan. 8:21 The male goat is the king of Greece, and the great horn between its eyes is the first king.



The Persian Ram

- The Medes & Persians were related and occupied the Iranian Plateau.
- Persians become stronger & Cyrus conquers the Medes & incorporates them.



- Cyrus conquers Lydia in 547 BCE (North)
- He conquers Babylon in 539 BCE (West)
- Cyrus' son Cambyses conquers Egypt in 525 BCE (South)

- Xerxes tries in 480 BCE
- Both turned back
- Greece will remember this...



The Greek Goat

- Greece evens the score & then some ~
- Alexander (ripe old age of 25) defeats the Persians in 331 BCE & by 326 BCE has conquered all the way to the headwaters of the Indus River in Northeast India

- By 301 BCE the Greek empire is divided up into 4 kingdoms among Alexander's 4 main generals

Vision moves forward & back

Dan. 8:9 ¶ Out of one of them came another horn, a little one, which grew exceedingly great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the beautiful land.

Dan. 8:10 It grew as high as the host of heaven. It threw down to the earth some of the host and some of the stars, and trampled on them.

Dan. 8:11 Even against the prince of the host it acted arrogantly; it took the regular burnt offering away from him and overthrew the place of his sanctuary.

Dan. 8:12 Because of wickedness, the host was given over to it together with the regular burnt offering;^a it cast truth to the ground, and kept prospering in what it did.

Attacks the Daily

- Assumes the role of the priest
- Takes away the “daily”
- Human power & priesthood between believer & God
- Casts truth to the ground by changing law – Power only given by God

2Cor. 5:18 Now all these things are
from God, who reconciled us to
Himself through Christ and gave us the
ministry of reconciliation,

Dan. 8:12 Because of wickedness, the host
was given over to it together with the
regular burnt offering; it cast truth to the

Rev. 14:12 ¶ ...keep the commandments of God and hold fast to the faith of Jesus.

Rev. 12:17 ...who keep the commandments of God and hold the testimony of Jesus.

Rev. 19:10 ... who hold the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.”

Ex. 29:38 ¶ Now this is what you shall offer on the altar: two lambs a year old regularly each day.

Ex. 29:39 One lamb you shall offer in the morning, and the other lamb you shall offer in the evening;

Ex. 29:42 It shall be a regular burnt offering throughout your generations at the entrance of the tent of meeting before the LORD, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there.

Lev. 16:5 He shall take from the congregation of the people of Israel two male goats for a sin offering, and one ram for a burnt offering.

Lev. 16:7 He shall take the two goats and set them before the LORD at the entrance of the tent of meeting;

Lev. 16:8 and Aaron shall cast lots on the two goats, one lot for the LORD and the other lot for Azazel.

Dan. 8:13 Then I heard a holy one speaking, and another holy one said to the one that spoke, "For how long is this vision concerning the regular burnt offering, the transgression that makes desolate, and the giving over of the sanctuary and host to be trampled?"

Dan. 8:14 And he answered him, "For two thousand three hundred evenings and mornings; then the sanctuary shall be restored to its rightful state."

Dan. 8:27 ¶ So I, Daniel, was overcome and lay sick for some days; then I arose and went about the king's business. But I was dismayed by the vision and did not understand it.

Heb. 8:1 ¶ Now the main point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens,

Heb. 8:2 a minister in the sanctuary and the true tent^a that the Lord, and not any mortal, has set up.

Zeph. 3:20 At that time I will bring you home,
at the time when I gather you;
for I will make you renowned and praised
among all the peoples of the earth,
when I restore your fortunes
