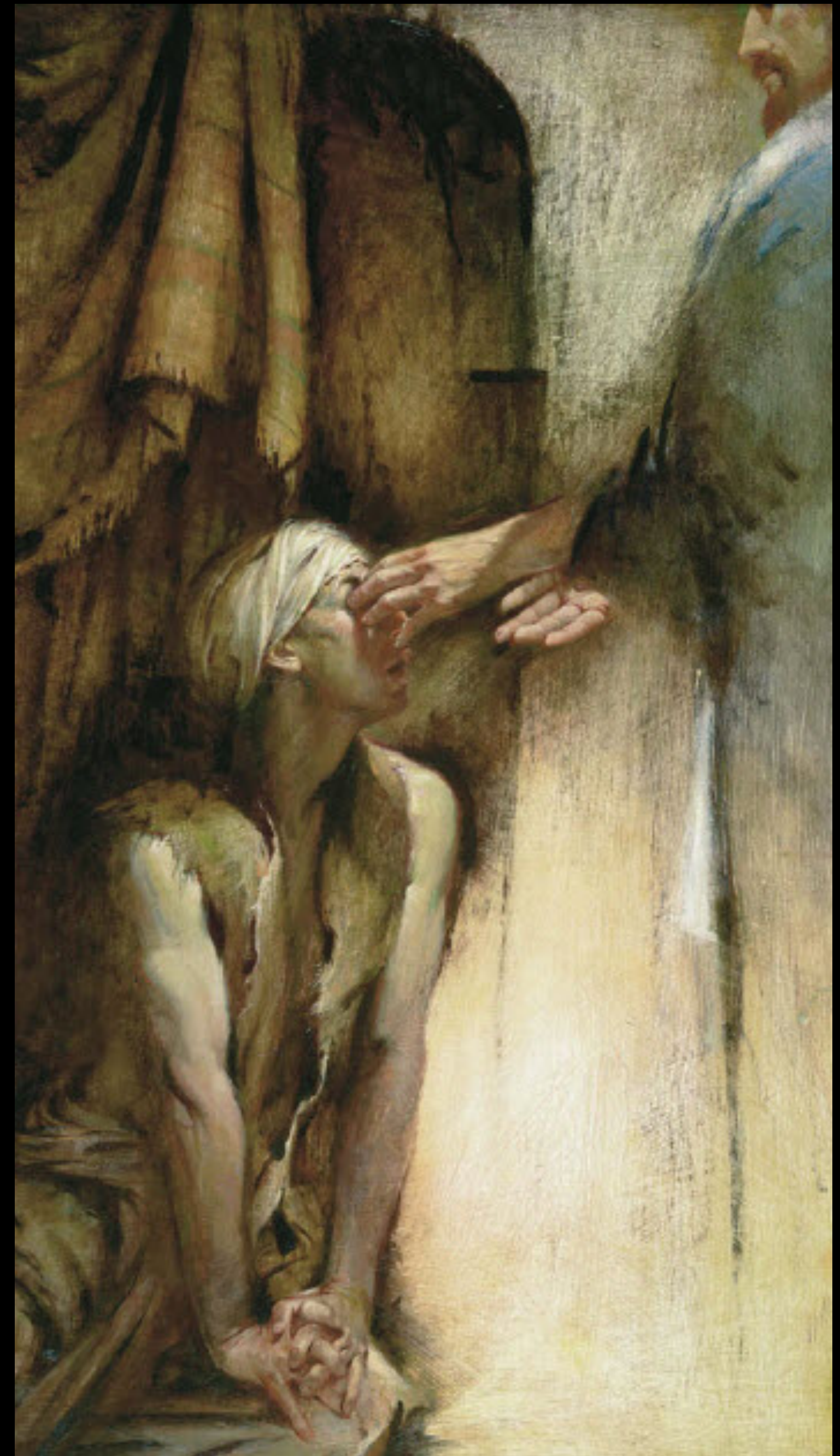
Acts 3:1 ¶ One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the hour of prayer, at three o'clock in the afternoon.

Acts 3:2 And a man lame from birth was being carried in. People would lay him daily at the gate of the temple called the Beautiful Gate so that he could ask for alms from those entering the temple.





John 9:1 ¶ As He  
passed by, He saw  
a man blind from  
birth.





Acts 3:3 When he saw Peter and John about to go into the temple, he asked them for alms.

Acts 3:4 Peter looked intently at him, as did John, and said, "Look at us."

Acts 3:5 And he fixed his attention on them, expecting to receive something from them.





Acts 3:6 But Peter said, "I have no silver or gold, but what I have I give you; in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, stand up and walk."





Acts 3:7 And he took him  
by the right hand and  
raised him up; and  
immediately his feet and  
ankles were made strong.

Luke 9:1 ¶ Then Jesus called the twelve  
together and gave them power and authority  
over all demons and to cure diseases,  
Luke 9:2 and he sent them out to proclaim the  
kingdom of God and to heal.





Luke 9:6 They departed and went  
through the villages, bringing the  
good news and curing diseases  
everywhere.





Luke 10:17 ¶ The seventy returned  
with joy, saying, "Lord, in your name  
even the demons submit to us!"





Luke 10:19 See, I have given you authority to tread on snakes and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing will hurt you.

Luke 10:20 Nevertheless, do not rejoice at this, that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.”





Luke 10:21 ¶ At that same hour Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.





Acts 3:8 With a leap he stood upright and began to walk; and he entered the temple with them, walking and leaping and praising God.

Acts 3:9 And all the people saw him walking and praising God;

Acts 3:10 and they were taking note of him as being the one who used to sit at the Beautiful Gate of the temple to beg alms, and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him.





Acts 3:11 ¶ While he was  
clinging to Peter and John, all  
the people ran together to  
them at the so-called portico  
of Solomon, full of  
amazement.





Acts 3:12 When Peter saw it, he addressed the people, "You Israelites, why do you wonder at this, or why do you stare at us, as though by our own power or piety we had made him walk?"





Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our ancestors has glorified his servant<sup>a</sup> Jesus, whom you handed over and rejected in the presence of Pilate, though he had decided to release him.

Acts 3:14 But you rejected the Holy and Righteous One and asked to have a murderer given to you,

Acts 3:15 and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses.





Acts 3:16 And by faith in his name,  
his name itself has made this man  
strong, whom you see and know;  
and the faith that is through  
Jesus has given him this perfect  
health in the presence of all of  
you.





Luke 10:17 ¶...“Lord, in your  
name even the demons  
submit to us!”

Acts 3:18 In this way God fulfilled what he had foretold through all the prophets, that his Messiah would suffer.





Acts 3:19 Repent therefore, and turn to God so that  
your sins may be wiped out,

Acts 3:20 so that times of refreshing may come from  
the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the  
Messiah appointed for you, that is, Jesus,

Acts 3:21 who must remain in heaven until the time of  
universal restoration that God announced long ago  
through his holy prophets.





John 9:2 His disciples  
asked him, "Rabbi, who  
sinned, this man or his  
parents, that he was  
born blind?"





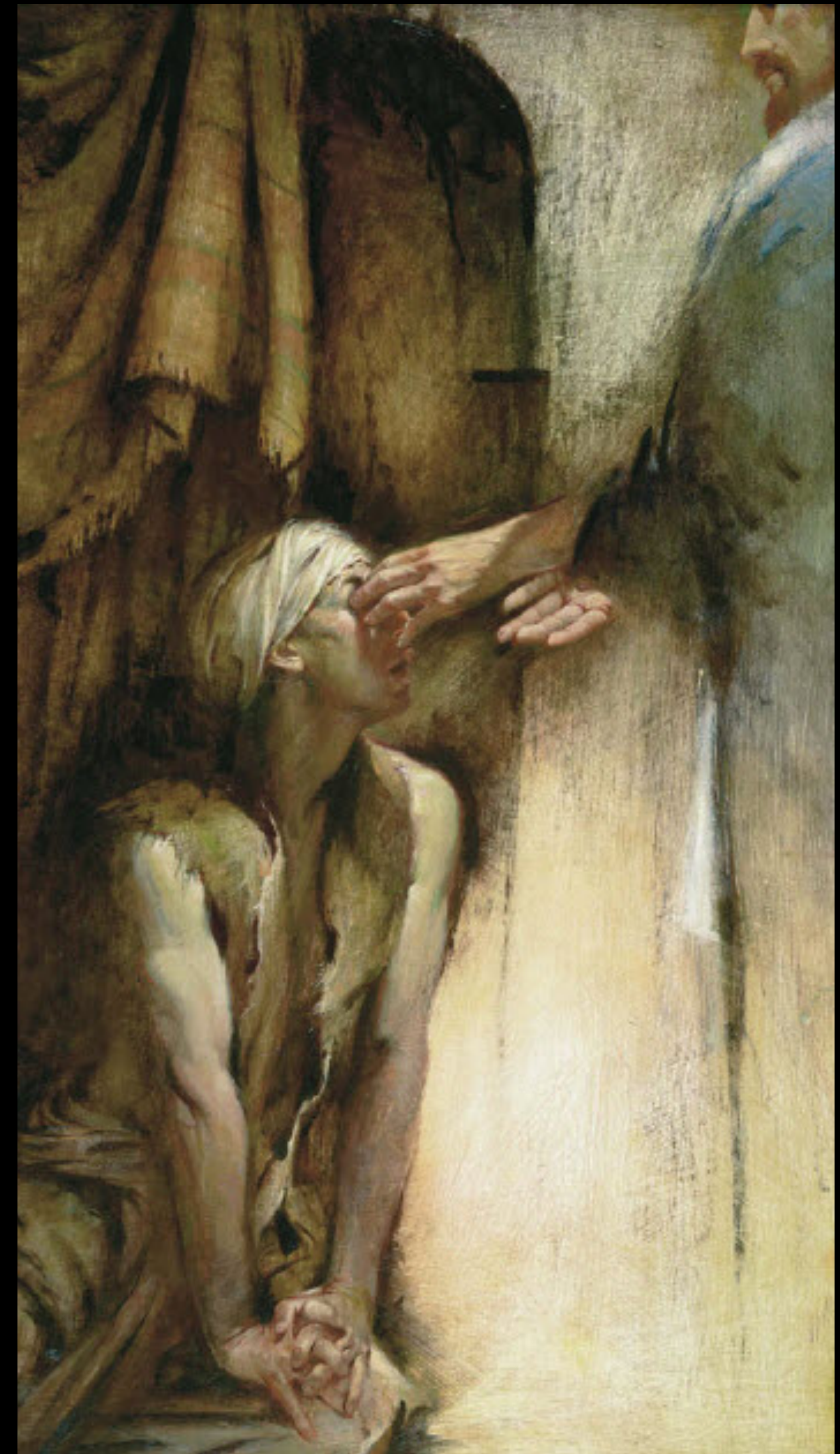
John 9:3 Jesus answered,

John 9:5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.”



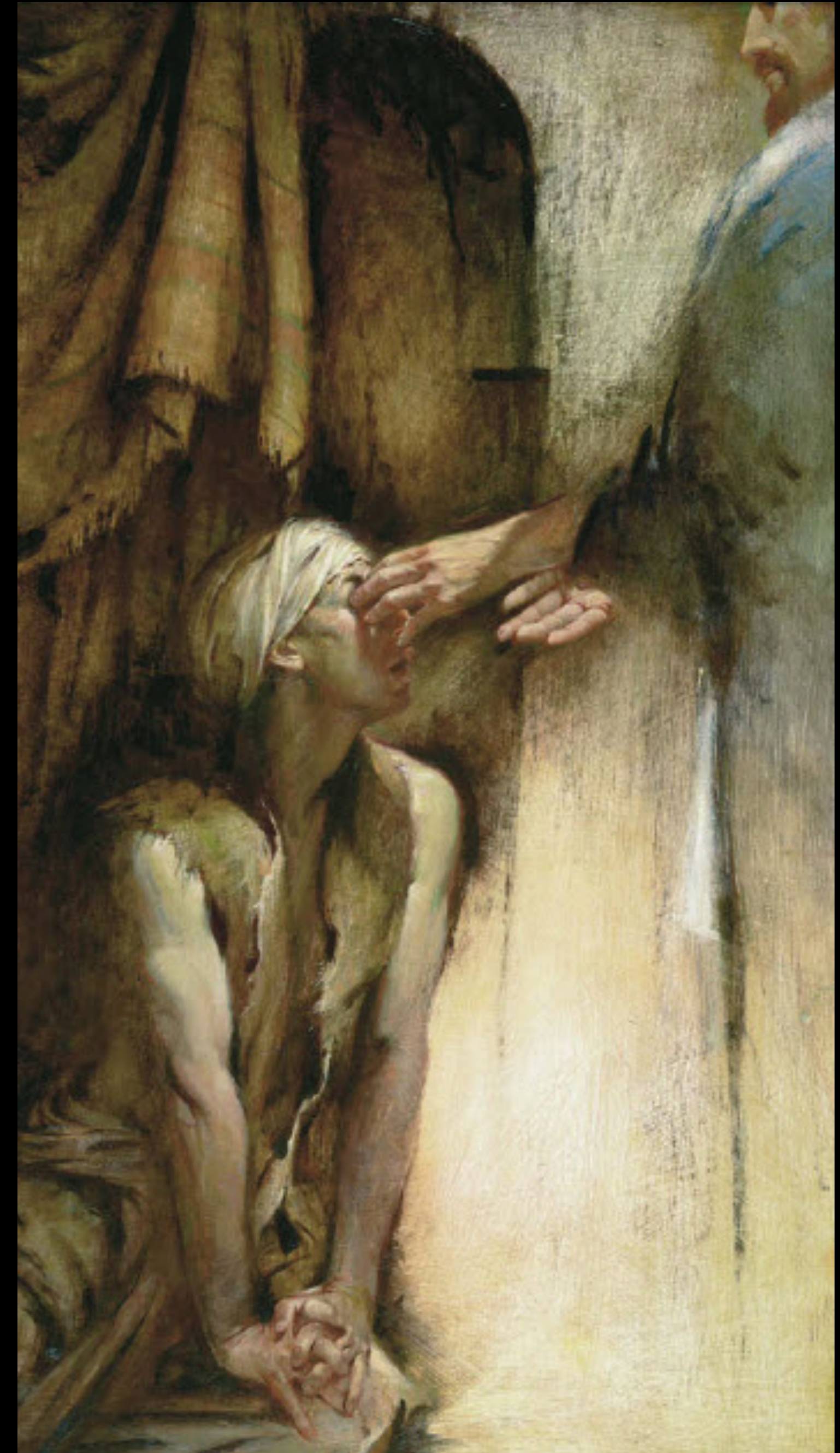


1Cor. 13:1 & 2 If I speak in the tongues of mortals

Acts 3:20 so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Messiah appointed for you, that is, Jesus,

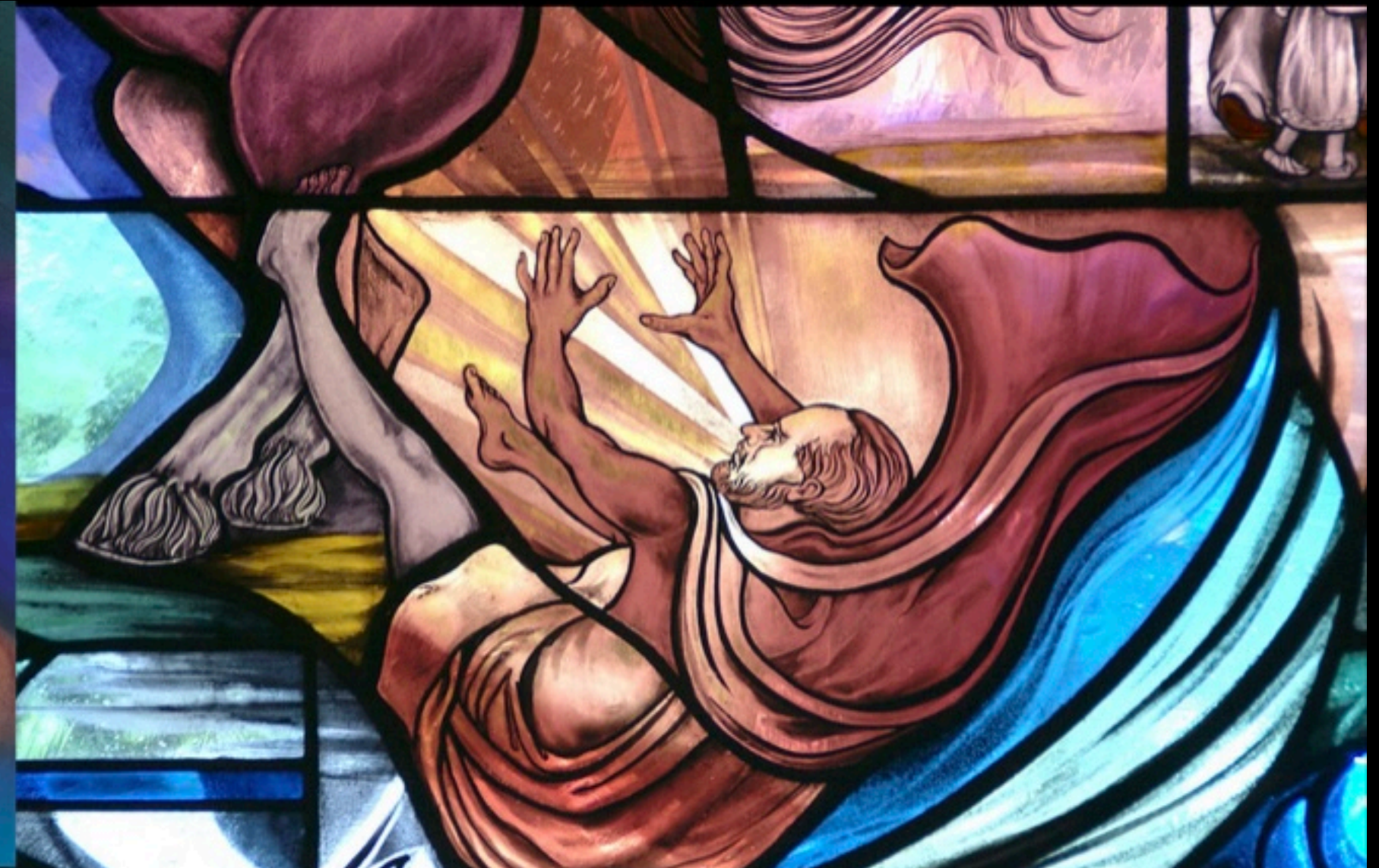
