


### Acts 2:2 And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were / / / sitting.










# Acts 2:4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.








# Acts 2:5 ¶ Now there were devout Jews from every nation under neaven living in Jerusalem.




### Psa. 71:18 And even when I am old and gray, O God, do not forsake

Until I declare Your strength to this generation, Your power to all who are to come.



### Acts 2:23 this man, handed over to you according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of those outside the law.








# Acts 2:24 But God raised him up, having freed him from death, because it was impossible for him to be held in its power.










### Acts 2:25 For David says concerning him, 'I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand so that I will not be shaken; ...








## Acts 2:44 All who believed were together and had all things in common; Acts 2:45 they would sell their possessions and goods and distribute the proceeds to all, as any had need.
