


Acts 6:1 \P ... the daily serving of food.








Acts 6:6 They had these men stand before the apostles, who prayed and laid their hands on





Acts 5:13 None of the rest dared to join them, but the people held them in high esteem.














Acts 6:7 A The word of God continued to spread; the number of the disciples increased greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith.*










Acts 6:8 ¶ Stephen, full of grace and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.
