"Acts: God's Friends, His Power, & the Ends of the Earth," pt 7



Acts 6:8 ¶ Stephen, full of grace and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.





Acts 6:9 Then some of those who belonged to the synagogue of the Freedmen (as it was called), Cyrenians, Alexandrians, and others of those from Cilicia and Asia, stood up and argued with Stephen. Acts 6:10 But they were unable to cope with the wisdom and the Spirit with which he was speaking.





Acts 6:11 Then they secretly instigated some men to say, "We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses and God."*

Acts 6:12 They stirred up the people as well as the elders and the scribes; then they suddenly confronted him, seized him, and brought him before the council.





Acts 6:13 They set up false witnesses who said, "This man never stops saying things against this holy place and the law,

Acts 6:14 for we have heard him say that this

Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and will

change the customs that Moses handed on to us."





Acts 6:15 And all who sat in the council looked intently at him, and they saw that his face was like the face of an angel. Acts 7:19 Then the high priest asked him, "Are these things so?"






Acts 7:2 And Stephen replied: ¶"Brothers and fathers, listen to me. The God of glory appeared to our ancestor Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Haran,*

Acts 7:3 and said to him, 'Leave your country and your relatives and go to the land that I will show you.'*





Acts 7:4 Then he left the country of the Chaldeans and settled in Haran. After his father died, God had him move from there to this country in which uou are now living.





Acts 7:5 He did not give him any of it as a heritage, not even a foot's length, but promised to give it to him as his possession and to his descendants after him, even though he had no child.






Acts 7:6 And God spoke in these terms, that his descendants would be resident aliens in a country belonging to others, who would enslave them and mistreat them during four hundred years.





Acts 7:8 Then he gave him the covenant of circumcision. And so Abraham became the father of Isaac and circumcised him on the eighth day, and Isaac did likewise to Jacob and Jacob to the twelve patriarchs.





Acts 7:9 ¶ "The patriarchs, jealous of Joseph, sold him into Egypt; but God was with








Acts 7:23 ¶ "When he was forty years old, it came into his heart to visit nis kinfolk, the Israelites.





Acts 7:25 He supposed that nis kinsfolk would understand that God through him was rescuing them, but they did not understand.





Acts 7:27 But the man who was wronging his neighbor pushed Moses aside, saying, "Who made you a ruler and a judge over us? Acts 7:28 Do you want to kill me as you killed the Egyptian yesterday?'





Acts 7:29 When he heard this, Moses fled and became a resident alien in the land of Midian. There he became the father of two sons.





Acts 7:34 I have surely seen the mistreatment of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their groaning, and I have come down to rescue them. Come now, I will send you to Egypt.'

Acts 7:35 ¶ "It was this Moses whom they rejected when they said, 'Who made you a ruler and a judge?' and whom God now sent as both ruler and liberator through the angel who appeared to him in the bush.






Acts 7:36 He led them out, having performed wonders and signs in Egypt, at the Red Sea, and in the wilderness for fortu years.






Acts 7:37 This is the Moses who said to the Israelites, 'God will raise up a prophet tor you trom your own people as he raised me up.'





Acts 7:38 He is the one who was in the congregation in the wilderness with the angel who spoke to him at Mount Sinai and with our ancestors, and he received living oracles to give to us.





Acts 7:39 Our ancestors were unwilling to obey him; instead, they pushed him aside, and in their hearts they turned back to Egypt,

Acts 7:40 saying to Aaron, 'Make gods for us who will lead the way for us; as for this Moses who led us out from the land of Egypt, we do not know what has happened to him.'





Acts 7:44 ¶ "Our ancestors had the tent of testimony in the widerness, as God directed when he spoke to Moses, ordering him to make it according to the pattern he had seen.





Acts 7:48 Yet the Most High does not dwell in houses made with human hands; as the prophet says,

Acts 7:49 ¶ 'Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool.

What kind of house will you build for me, says the Lord,

or what is the place of my rest?

Acts 7:50 Did not my hand make all these things?







Acts 7:52 Which of the prophets did your ancestors not persecute? They killed those who foretold the coming of the Righteous One, and now you have become his betrayers and murderers.






Acts 7:53 You are the ones who received the aw as ordained bu angels, and yet you have not kept it."






Acts 7:55 But being full of the Holy Spirit, he gazed intentlu into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God;








Acts 7:59 While theu were stoning Stephen, ne prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive mu 5DIrit."

Eph. 2:4 but God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us




