




Acts 11:12 The Spirit told me to go with them and not to make a distinction between them and us. These six brothers also accompanied me, and we entered the man's house.













Acts 10:44 ¶While Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who heard the word.









Acts 11:15 And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as it had upon us at the Deginning.











Acts 11:18 When they heard this, they were silenced. And they praised God, saying, "Then God has given even to the gentiles the repentance that leads to life."
