The fist is bahoshek

The second is tslamavet

What is the difference?

The difference is sight

Bahoshek is the kind of darkness you experienced as you move around at night. You lose color, clarity, and everything is shadows but your eyes adjust. It's dark but you can still move around.



Tslamavet is the kind of darkness you
experience inside of caves. Pitch darkness
where your eyes never adjust.
