

Heb. 12:7 ¶ Endure trials for the sake of discipline. God is treating you as children, for what child is there whom a parent does not discipline?

Heb. 12:8 If you do not have that discipline in which all children share, then you are illegitimate and not his children.


Heb. 12:9 Moreover, we had human parents to discipline us, and we

Father of spirits and live?

Heb. 12:10 For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our good, in order that we may share his holiness.

Heb. 12:11 Now, discipline always seems painful rather than pleasant at the time, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.*





Heb. 12:12 ¶ Therefore lift your drooping hands and strengthen your weak knees

Heb. 12:13 and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed.
