John 3:14 And just as Moses
lifted up the serpent in the
wilderness, so must the Son
of Man be lifted up,



John 19:16 Then he handed him over to them to be crucified. ¶ So they took Jesus, John 19:17 and carrying the cross by himself he went out to what is called the Place of the Skull, which in Hebrew is called Golgotha.



John 19:18 There they
crucified him and with him two
others, one on either side,
with Jesus between them.



John 19:19 Pilate also had an inscription written and put on the cross. It read, "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews."

John 19:20 Many of the Jews read this inscription because the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city, and it was written in Hebrew, in Latin, and in Greek.



John 19:21 Then the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews,' but, 'This man said, I am King of the Jews.'"

John 19:22 Pilate answered, "What I have written I have written."



John 19:23 When the soldiers had crucified Jesus, they took his clothes and divided them into four parts, one for each soldier. They also took his tunic; now the tunic was seamless, woven in one piece from the top.



John 19:24 So they said to one another, "Let us not tear it but cast lots for it to see who will get it."

This was to fulfill what the scripture says,

¶ "They divided my clothes among themselves,

and for my clothing they cast lots."

John 19:25 ¶ And that is what the soldiers did...

John 19:28 ¶ After this, when Jesus knew that all was now finished, he said (in order to fulfill the scripture), "I am thirsty."

John 19:29 A jar full of sour wine was standing there. So they put a sponge full of the wine on a branch of hyssop and held it to his mouth.
