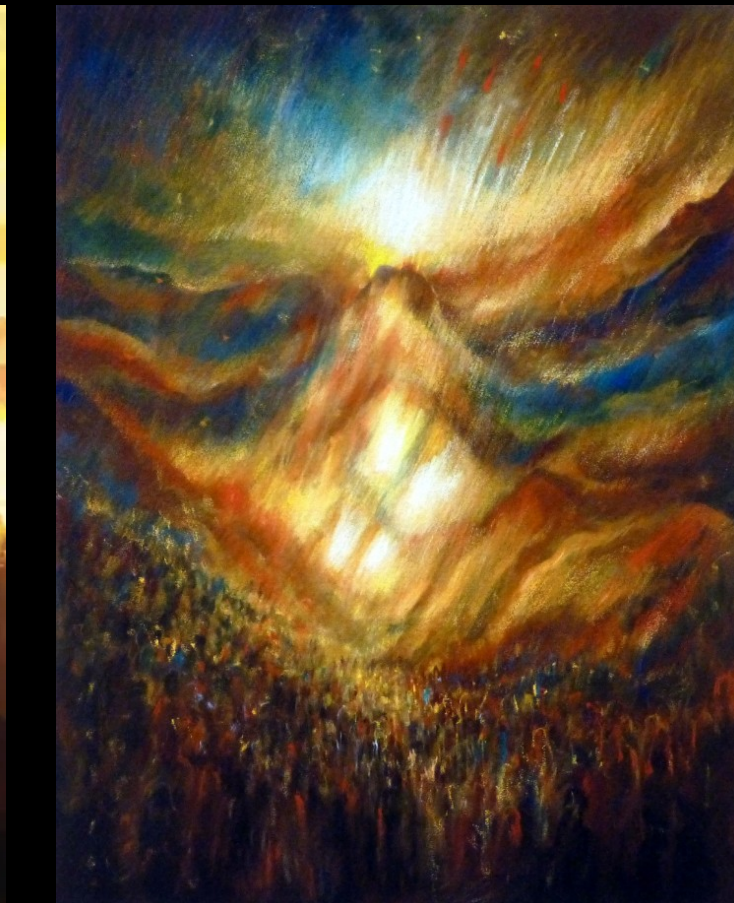

“From the Word to Stone to Flesh: Torah’s Living Covenant,” Pt 19



Ex. 33:11 Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend...

Ex. 3:10 Now go, I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people, the Israelites, out of Egypt.”



Ex. 3:12 He said, "I will be with you,
and this shall be the sign for you
that it is I who sent you: when you
have brought the people out of
Egypt, you shall serve God on this
mountain."



Ex. 19:3 Then Moses went up to God; the LORD called to him from the mountain, “Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob and tell the Israelites:

Ex. 19:4 ‘You have seen what I did to the Egyptians and how I bore you on eagles’ wings and brought you to myself.



Ex. 19:5 Now, therefore, if you obey my voice
and keep my covenant, you shall be my
treasured possession out of all the peoples.
Indeed, the whole earth is mine,
Ex. 19:6 but you shall be for me a priestly
kingdom and a holy nation.' These are the
words that you shall speak to the Israelites."



Ex. 19:13 No hand shall touch them,
but they shall be stoned or shot with
arrows; whether animal or human
being, they shall not live.' When the
trumpet sounds a long blast, they
may go up on the mountain."



Ex. 20:18 ¶ When all the people
witnessed the thunder and lightning,
the sound of the trumpet, and the
mountain smoking, they were afraid^m
and trembled and stood at a
distance



Ex. 20:19 and said to
Moses, "You speak to us,
and we will listen, but do
not let God speak to us,
lest we die."



Ex. 20:21 Then the people stood at a distance, while Moses drew near to the thick darkness where God was.

Ex. 20:22 ¶ The LORD said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the Israelites: You have seen for yourselves how I spoke with you from heaven.



Ex. 24:3 ¶ Moses went and told the people all the words of the LORD and all the ordinances, and all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words that the LORD has spoken we will do."



Ex. 24:18 Moses entered the cloud and went up on the mountain. Moses was on the mountain for forty days and forty nights.



Ex. 31:18 ¶ When God finished speaking with Moses on Mount Sinai, he gave him the two tablets of the covenant, tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.



Ex. 32:1 ¶ When the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people gathered around Aaron and said to him, "Come, make gods for us, who shall go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him."



Ex. 32:4 ... "These are
your gods, O Israel,
who brought you up out
of the land of Egypt!"



Ex. 32:24 So I said to them,
'Whoever has gold, take it
off'; so they gave it to me,
and I threw it into the fire,
and out came this calf!"



Ex. 32:29 Moses said, "Today you have been ordained for the service of the LORD, each one at the cost of a son or a brother, and so have brought a blessing on yourselves this day."



Ex. 32:30 ¶ On the next day
Moses said to the people, "You
have sinned a great sin. But now I
will go up to the LORD; perhaps I
can make atonement for your
sin."



Ex. 32:31 So Moses returned to the LORD and said, “Alas, this people has sinned a great sin; they have made for themselves gods of gold.

Ex. 32:32 But now, if you will only forgive their sin—but if not, please blot me out of the book that you have written.”



Ex. 32:33 But the LORD
said to Moses, "Whoever
has sinned against me I
will blot out of my book."



Ex. 32:34 But now go, lead the people to the place about which I have spoken to you; see, my angel shall go in front of you. Nevertheless, when the day for punishment comes, I will punish them for their sin.”



Ex. 32:35 ¶ Then the LORD
sent a plague on the
people, because they made
the calf—the one that
Aaron had made.



Ex. 33:1 ¶ The LORD said to Moses,
“Go, leave this place, you and the
people whom you have brought up out
of the land of Egypt, and go to the
land of which I swore to Abraham,
Isaac, and Jacob, saying, ‘To your
descendants I will give it.’”



Ex. 33:2 I will send an angel before you, and I will drive out the Canaanites, the Amorites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

Ex. 33:3 Go up^k to a land flowing with milk and honey, but I will not go up among you, or I would consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people.”



Ex. 33:11 Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then he would return to the camp, but his young assistant, Joshua son of Nun, would not leave the tent.



Ex. 33:12 ¶ Moses said to the LORD,
“See, you have said to me, ‘Bring up
this people,’ but you have not let me
know whom you will send with me. Yet
you have said, ‘I know you by name,
and you have also found favor in my
sight.’”



Ex. 33:13 Now if I have found favor
in your sight, please show me
your ways, so that I may know
you and find favor in your sight.
Consider, too, that this nation is
your people.”



Ex. 33:14 He said, "My
presence will go with
you, and I will give you
rest."



Ex. 33:15 And he said to him, "If your presence will not go, do not bring us up from here.

Ex. 33:16 For how shall it be known that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people, unless you go with us? In this way, we shall be distinct, I and your people, from every people on the face of the earth."



Ex. 33:17 ¶ The LORD said to
Moses, “I will also do this thing
that you have asked, for you
have found favor in my sight,
and I know you by name.”



Ex. 33:18 Moses said,
“Please show me your
glory.”



Ex. 34:1 ¶ The LORD said to Moses, "Cut two tablets of stone like the former ones, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the former tablets, which you broke."



Ex. 34:5 The LORD
descended in the cloud and
stood with him there and
proclaimed the name, "The
LORD."



Ex. 40:12 Then you shall bring Aaron
and his sons to the entrance of the tent
of meeting and wash them with water
Ex. 40:13 and put on Aaron the sacred
vestments, and you shall anoint him and
consecrate him, so that he may serve
me as priest.



Heb. 12:18 ¶ You have not come to something^u that can be touched, a blazing fire, and darkness, and gloom, and a tempest,

Heb. 12:19 and the sound of a trumpet, and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that not another word be spoken to them.

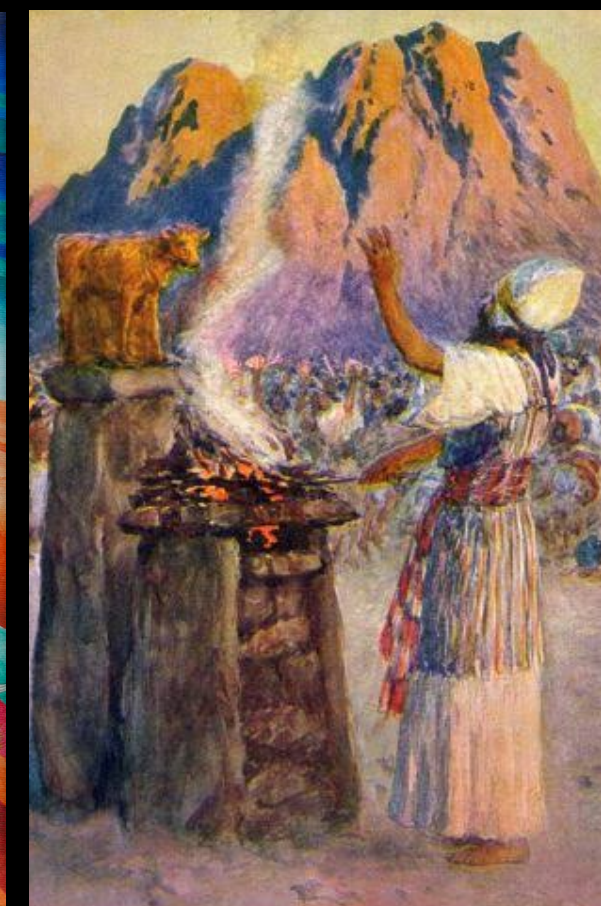


Heb. 12:22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering,
