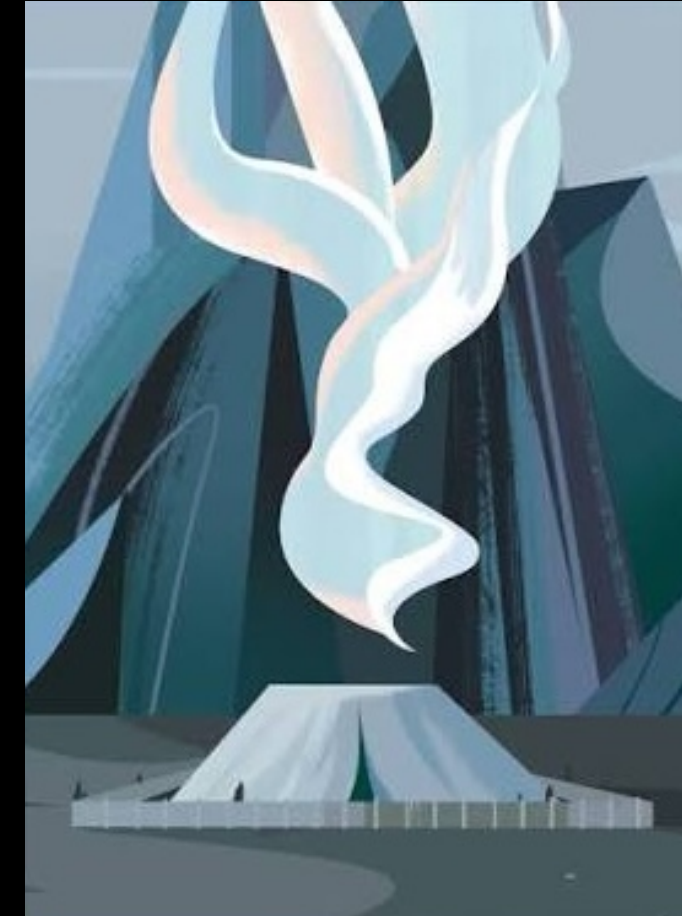




“The Covenant’s Shadow: The Priesthood - Enemies Interceding for Enemies”

“From the Word to Stone to Flesh: Torah’s Living Covenant,” Pt 21



Job 1:5 And when the feast days had run their course, Job would send and sanctify them, and he would rise early in the morning and offer burnt offerings according to the number of them all, for Job said, "It may be that my children have sinned and cursed God in their hearts." This is what Job always did.



Job 16:21 O that a man
might plead with God
As a man with his
neighbor!



Ex. 19:5 Now, therefore, if you obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession out of all the peoples. Indeed, the whole earth is mine,
Ex. 19:6 but you shall be for me a priestly kingdom and a holy nation.' These are the words that you shall speak to the Israelites."



Gen. 49:5 ¶ "Simeon and Levi are brothers;

Their swords are implements of violence.

Gen. 49:6 Let my soul not enter into their council; Let not my glory be united with their assembly;

Because in their anger they slew men,

And in their self-will they lamed oxen.



Gen. 49:7 Cursed be their

anger, for it is fierce;

And their wrath, for it is cruel.

I will disperse them in Jacob,

And scatter them in Israel.



Ex. 28:9 You shall take two onyx stones and engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel,

Ex. 28:21 There shall be twelve stones with names corresponding to the names of the sons of Israel; they shall be like signets, each engraved with its name, for the twelve tribes.



Ex. 28:29 So Aaron shall bear the names of the sons of Israel in the breastpiece of judgment on his heart when he goes into the holy place, for a continual remembrance before the LORD.



Ex. 39:30 ¶ They made the
rosette of the holy diadem of
pure gold and wrote on it an
inscription, like the engraving of
a signet, "Holy to the LORD."

Heb. 7:23 ¶ Furthermore, the former priests were many in number because they were prevented by death from continuing in office,
Heb. 7:24 but he holds his priesthood permanently because he continues forever.



Heb. 7:25 Consequently, he is able for all time to save^t those who approach God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.

Heb. 7:26 ¶ For it was fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, blameless, undefiled, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens.



Heb. 7:27 Unlike the other^u high priests, he has no need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins and then for those of the people; this he did once for all when he offered himself.



Rom. 5:8 But God proves his love for us
in that while we still were sinners Christ
died for us.

Rom. 5:9 Much more surely, therefore,
since we have now been justified by his
blood, will we be saved through him
from the wrath of God.



Rom. 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, much more surely, having been reconciled, will we be saved by his life.

Rom. 5:11 But more than that, we even boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.



2Cor. 5:17 So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; look, new things have come into being!

2Cor. 5:18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and has given us the ministry of reconciliation;



2Cor. 5:19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us.

2Cor. 5:21 For our sake God made the one who knew no sin to be sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.



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Heb. 8:1 ¶ Now the main point
in what we are saying is this:
we have such a high priest,
one who is seated at the right
hand of the throne of the
Majesty in the heavens,



Is. 53:10 ¶ But the LORD was pleased

To crush Him, putting Him to grief;
If He would render Himself as a guilt
offering,

He will see His offspring,

He will prolong His days,

And the good pleasure of the LORD

will prosper in His hand.





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
