1Sam. 10:6 “Then the Spirit of the LORD will come upon you mightily, and you shall prophesy with them and be changed into another man.

1Sam. 10:10 When they came to the hill there, behold, a group of prophets met him; and the Spirit of God came upon him mightily, so that he prophesied among them.

1Sam. 11:6 Then the Spirit of God came upon Saul mightily when he heard these words, and he became very angry.



1Sam. 16:14 ¶ Now the spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD tormented him.

1Sam. 18:11 ^aSaul hurled the spear for he thought, "I will pin David to the wall." But David escaped from his presence twice.

1Sam. 18:12 ¶ Now Saul was afraid of David, for the LORD was with him but had departed from Saul.



1Sam. 24:4 The men of David said to him, "Here is the day of which the LORD said to you, 'I will give your enemy into your hand, and you shall do to him as it seems good to you.'" Then David went and stealthily cut off a corner of Saul's cloak.



1Sam. 24:5 Afterward David was stricken to the heart because he had cut off a corner of Saul's cloak.

1Sam. 24:6 He said to his men, "The LORD forbid that I should do this thing to my lord, the LORD'S anointed, to raise my hand against him; for he is the LORD'S anointed."



1Sam. 24:13 As the ancient proverb says, 'Out of the wicked comes forth wickedness'; but my hand shall not be against you.
