Institutionalism vs Incarnation:

The Dangerous Dichotomy of Race & the Church, pt 5



Rev. 13:13 He performs great signs, so that
he even makes fire come down out of
heaven to the earth in the presence of men.



Rev. 17:6 And I saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the saints and the blood of the witnesses to Jesus. ¶ When I saw her, I was greatly amazed.

Rev. 17:7 But the angel said to me, “Why are you so amazed..?”



Rev. 18:4 Then I heard another voice from heaven
saying,

“Come out of her, my people,
so that you do not take part in her sins,
and so that you do not share
in her plagues;



Ex. 33:11 Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses
face to face, as one speaks to a friend.





Ex. 19:11 and prepare for the third day, because on the third day the LORD will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.

Ex. 19:13 No hand shall touch them, but they shall be stoned or shot with arrows; whether animal or human being, they shall not live.' When the trumpet sounds a long blast, they may go up on the mountain."



Ex. 20:18 ¶ When all the people witnessed the thunder and lightning, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking, they were afraid and trembled and stood at a distance,



Ex. 20:19 and said to Moses, “You speak to us, and we will listen; but do not let God speak to us, or we will die.”



Ex. 20:21 Then the people stood at a distance, while Moses drew near to the thick darkness where God was.

Ex. 20:22 ¶ The LORD said to Moses: Thus you shall say to the Israelites: “You have seen for yourselves that I spoke with you from heaven.



Ex. 31:18 ¶ When God finished speaking with Moses on Mount Sinai, he gave him the two tablets of the covenant, tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.



Ex. 32:1 ¶ When the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people gathered around Aaron, and said to him, “Come, make gods for us, who shall go before us; as for this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.”



Ex. 32:24 So I said to them, 'Whoever has gold, take it off'; so they gave it to me, and I threw it into the fire, and out came this calf!"



Ex. 32:30 ¶ On the next day Moses said to the people, “You have sinned a great sin. But now I will go up to the LORD; perhaps I can make atonement for your sin.”

Ex. 32:31 So Moses returned to the LORD and said, “Alas, this people has sinned a great sin; they have made for themselves gods of gold.

Ex. 32:32 But now, if you will only forgive their sin—but if not, blot me out of the book that you have written.”



Ex. 32:33 But the LORD said to Moses, “Whoever has sinned against me I will blot out of my book.

Ex. 32:34 But now go, lead the people to the place about which I have spoken to you; see, my angel shall go in front of you. Nevertheless, when the day comes for punishment, I will punish them for their sin.”

Ex. 32:35 ¶ Then the LORD sent a plague on the people, because they made the calf—the one that Aaron made.



Ex. 32:11 ¶ Then aMoses entreated the LORD his God, and said, “O LORD, why does Your anger burn against Your people whom You have brought out from the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand?

Ex. 32:12 “Why should a the Egyptians speak, saying, ‘With evil intent He brought them out to kill them in the mountains and to destroy them from the face of the earth’? Turn from Your burning anger and change Your mind about doing harm to Your people.



Ex. 32:13 "Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, Your servants to whom You aswore by Yourself, and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heavens, and call this land of which I have spoken I will give to your descendants, and they shall inherit it forever.'"

Ex. 32:14 So the LORD changed His mind about the harm which He said He would do to His people.



Ex. 33:11 Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend.

John 16:26 On that day you will ask in my name. I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf;

John 16:27 for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.
