John 3:14 And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

John 3:15 that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.



John 3:13 No one has ascended into  
heaven except the one who  
descended from heaven, the Son  
of Man.



John 3:15 that whoever believes in  
him may have eternal life.



John 3:16 ¶ "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.



John 13:34 I give you a new  
commandment, that you love one  
another. Just as I have loved you,  
you also should love one another.



John 14:21 They who have my  
commandments and keep them are those  
who love me; and those who love me will be  
loved by my Father, and I will love them and  
reveal myself to them.”



John 14:22 Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, “Lord, how is it that you will reveal yourself to us, and not to the world?”

John 14:23 Jesus answered him, “Those who love me will keep my word, and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.



John 16:26 On that day you will ask in my name. I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf;

John 16:27 for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.

Gen. 12:7 Then the LORD appeared to Abram, and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built there an altar to the LORD, who had appeared to him.



Gen. 12:1 ¶ Now the LORD said to Abram, “Go from your country and your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you.

Gen. 12:2 I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.



Gen. 12:3 I will bless those who bless  
you, and the one who curses you I  
will curse; and in you all the families  
of the earth shall be blessed.”





John 9:35 ¶ Jesus heard that they had driven him out, and when he found him, he said, “Do you believe in the Son of Man?”

John 9:36 He answered, “And who is he, sir? Tell me, so that I may believe in him.”

John 9:37 Jesus said to him, “You have seen him, and the one speaking with you is he.”

John 9:38 He said, “Lord, I believe.” And he worshiped him. 

John 2:22 After he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this; and they believed the scripture and the word that Jesus had spoken.
